### Managing Land For Wildlife

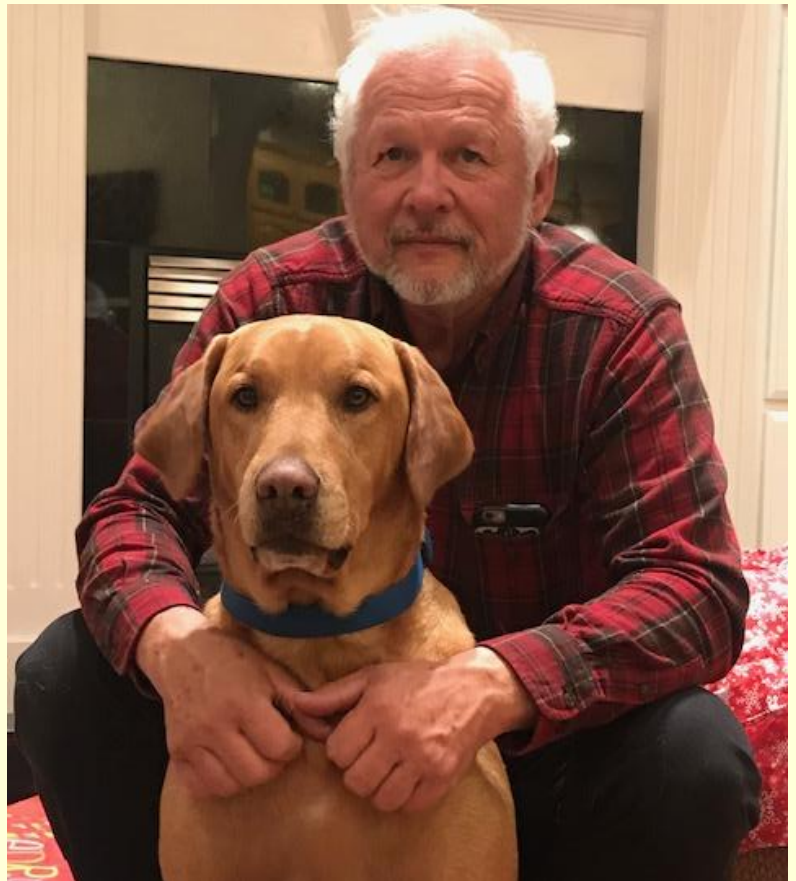
